Parents of underage players are encouraged to become members of the club. Adult non-playing membership is €40.

In the event of Kilkenny reaching the All Ireland series and a limited number of family tickets become available, first preference will be given to those with both adult & child membership paid.

GAA INJURY SCHEME - KNOW THE PROCEDURE

Players and managers must adhere to the following in order to ensure reimbursement of injury costs. (For juvenile players parents should ensure injury is reported as below).

- In the event of sustaining an injury either at an official club training session or official club match you must inform the team manager immediately. In the event of a club match the manager will then inform the referee to ensure incident is recorded in his report.
- In the event of an injury only becoming apparent shortly after an official club training session or official club match you must inform the manager as soon as possible.
- Contact should be made with Eddie Power (club secretary - 087 9264810) immediately to inform him of a potential claim. He will advise and issue claim form if appropriate.
- Failure to notify the club secretary on time may render the claim invalid and the club may not be in a financial position to reimburse injury costs.
- Players must wear an approved helmet during training and matches and all players no matter what age must wear a gum shield during all GAA football training sessions and games.
- Only fully paid up members are eligible to avail of the injury scheme.

Where a claim is to be submitted it is up to the injured player to ensure that the form is properly completed and that receipts are in order.

It is also the player's responsibility to have all documents back with the Club Secretary early enough to allow the claim to be processed by the club (60 day rule applies)

PLEASE NOTE PHYSIOTHERAPY IS NOT COVERED BY GAA INSURANCE. THE CLUB MAY NOT BE IN A POSITION TO REIMBURSE SUCH EXPENSES. THE MATTER SHOULD BE AGREED WITH CLUB SECRETARY PRIOR TO ARRANGING SUCH TREATMENT.
